

(a) Locate anchor points in the truck bed (Fig. 1-1).




(b) Insert bungee loop from the underside of the D-ring cleat and attach to the outside of the cleat handle as shown (Fig. 1-2).




(c) Repeat Step 1 (b) for other side.



(d) Confirm completed assembly, making sure the net handle faces toward the rear of the vehicle (Fig. 1-3).
