





# 1. Prepare the Vehicle.


- (a) Open the package and check for damage.
- (b) Ensure the rear bumper protector and the vehicle bumper are between 60°F (15°C) and 109°F (43°C).
  - (c) Open the trunk lid.
  - (d) Saturate a clean lint free cloth with VDCapproved cleaner (i.e. 3M<sup>™</sup> Prep Solvent-70 or isopropyl alcohol) and clean the top surface of the rear bumper (Fig. 1-1).
  - (e) Wipe the cleaned bumper surface with a clean, dry, lint free cloth.
- NOTE: When using 3M<sup>™</sup> Prep Solvent-70, follow the manufacturer directions. Do not allow the cleaner to air dry on the part.
- **NOTE:** Once cleaned, do not contaminate this surface by touching it with bare skin.


# 2. Install the Rear Bumper Protector.


- (a) Carefully hold the rear bumper protector by its edges and pull all of the plastic liner tabs at the ends of the tapes to expose approximately 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (40mm) of tape (Fig. 2-1).
- **NOTE:** Once the liner is removed from the rear bumper protector, the surface of the tape must not be touched.

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(b) Ensure all of the tabs are folded so they can be accessed from the top once the protector is placed on the rear bumper (Fig. 2-2).

- (c) Align the 'I' in the PRIUS logo with the lift gate striker (Fig. 2-3).
- (d) While keeping the rear bumper protector aligned, lower the right hand corner until it contacts the bumper and starts to stick. Use a rolling motion and press the rest of the protector from right to left. <u>Do not</u> allow both ends of the protector to stick to the bumper before the center touches.
- (e) Once the exposed tape has been secured, pull out and discard the liners in the order shown to allow full tape contact with the rear bumper (Fig. 2-4).
- (f) Press down firmly around the entire perimeter of the protector to ensure full adhesion of the tape to the rear bumper.
  - (g) Close the trunk lid.

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Check:	Look For:
Accessory Function Checks	
Visual alignment	The bumper protector should be visually centered left to right, centered to the strike latch
	The front edge of the bumper protector should appear visually parallel to the vehicle bumper
	The protector lip should align with the contour of the bumper surface
Proper tape adhesion	A gap of approximately 1mm (0.04") is designed to exist under the edges of the protector and the bumper
	No gap is allowed between the tape and the bumper
Vehicle Function Checks	
Confirm trunk lid closes properly	The protector must not hinder the closure of the trunk lid
Vehicle Appearance Check	
After accessory installation and removal of protective cover(s), perform a visual inspection.	Ensure no damage (including scuffs and scratches) was caused during the installation process. (For PPO installations, refer to TMS Accessory Quality Shipping Standard.)
