Procedure


Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.




This document covers such items as:

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

- 1. Open the vehicle rear hatch door and remove the snap covers located on the rear trim panel (driver and passenger side) (Fig. 1). Discard the snap covers.
- 2. Connect the two poles inside the cargo cover, as you would tent poles.
- 3. Place the cargo cover pole ends (driver and passenger side) into the rear slots (Fig 2A) that will hold the pole in place.
- 4. Wrap the four (4) straps with Velcro around the corresponding headrest posts (Fig 2B). Adjust the fabric of the cover for a good appearance.
- 5. Snap the cargo cover into place (one snap on each side) (Fig 3).
